40 000 known species, estimated number is far higher 50 000 to over 100 000 species


large number of endemics (2.7%) – flora + karstic subterranean fauna + freshwater fish

Nature protection in Croatia

The Nature Protection Act (OG No. 80/2013)

Development and improvement of national policy framework on nature protection and alien species

MENP – Ministry of Environmental and Nature Protection is the central state administration body competent for nature protection

CAEN – Croatian Agency for the Environment and Nature is the central institute dealing with expert tasks of nature conservation in Croatia







The Nature Protection Act

Article 68. - Ban of import, placing on the market and/or introduction into the nature on the territory of the Republic of Croatia of alien taxa

Requirement for permission for:

Article 69. - Import, placing on the market of the Republic of Croatia and/or introduction into the nature of Croatia of alien taxa

Article 78. - Breeding/cultivation of alien taxa

Ordinance on the method of preparing and implementing risk assessment studies with respect to introduction, reintroduction and breeding of wild taxa (OG 35/08)




The Nature Protection Act

Article 86. – Escape to nature (the owner is obliged to prevent escape and is responsible for the damage)

Article 73. – In case of accidental introduction of alien species into the nature, the competent authority can issue an Order on removing or preventing the further spread of introduced alien species

New bill on prevention of the introduction and spread of alien and invasive alien species and their management

- Inter-Ministerial Task Force, 2014
- Transfer of the necessary enforcement and misdemeanour provisions of the new Regulation (EU) No. 1143/2014 (OJ L 317, 4.11.2014) into national legislation
- Regulation Alien Species Management & RA Protocols (in preparation)
- Ordinance "White list" & "Black list" (in preparation)
